

Per Florida Statutes Section 403.70605 – Solid Waste Collection Services in Competition with Private Companies, the City is required to hold this Advisability Hearing, at which time it will receive comments concerning the advisability of the City to provide solid waste collection services within its service area.

**July 14, 2020** – City Attorney Obos reviewed the process necessary to move to a one hauler contract, which he advised would require a 3-year noticed waiting period with notice to the current haulers to avoid any compensation. This did not bind the city to take action at that time, but if none is taken the 3-year period will start over. Commission voted 3-2 to approve the process to notify current garbage haulers, with Commissioners Henderson and Fairbanks voting in opposition.

**July 28, 2020** – A Notice of Intent to displace private companies providing solid waste collection services was sent by certified mail to all garbage haulers providing services within the City of Callaway.

**March 20, 2023** – Notice of this Advisability Hearing was sent to all current garbage haulers providing services within the City.

**March 15, 2023** – A Notice of Hearing was published on the City’s website.

**April 1, 2023** – A public notice of the hearing was published in the City’s April Newsletter, which was mailed to all citizens with their monthly utility bill.

If so directed, an Invitation to Bid will be issued, allowing interested parties to bid on the opportunity to provide these services to the citizens.
