

PUBLIC HEARING – PRESENTATION OF THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021.

1. **Public Announcement** – Ad Valorem Tax Rate (Trim Notice)
Pursuant to Section 200.065(2)(e), F.S., “Notice of Tentative property Taxes for the City of Callaway, Florida” (TRIM NOTICE) the proposed ad valorem rate for the Fiscal Year 2021/22 was advertised to be a maximum of 3.5344 mils. This millage rate would be greater than the current year’s rolled-back rate of 2.6400 mils. After reviewing revenue projections and proposed expenditure levels for the 2021/22 Fiscal Year, the General Fund budget is balanced at a tentative rate of 2.7500 mils, which is more than the current year’s roll back rate by 0.1100, an increase of 4.1667%. This means 2.7500 mils is to be levied to fund the Fiscal Year 2021/22 Budget.
2. **Tentative FY2021/22 Budget and City Manager’s Budget Message**
Review tentative budget and points of discussion.

The Public’s opportunity to speak or ask questions regarding the Fiscal Year 2021/22 millage rate and proposed budget.
