Consent and approval of the City Commission may be given during duly called and constituted session of said Commission, identifying said budget amendments or adjustments.

SECTION 4. ENCUMBRANCES UNDER CONTRACT: That valid commitments for goods and services which remain uncompleted as of September 30, 2021, shall not lapse, but shall be automatically re-appropriated and incorporated into the final budget of the City for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the latter of its adoption or 12:01 A.M., October 1, 2021.
